A bookmark with a rainbow stack of hearts, each with a different blackwork fill. Stitches used: Back-stitch, stem-stitch.


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<u>Notes</u>

Blackwork motifs are back-stitched using a single strand of embroidery floss. Outlines are worked in stem-stitch using a double strand of floss. The model is shown on 14-count Aida cloth and uses the following colours of DMC thread:

Back-stitch (single strand)	Stem-stitch (double strand)
DMC 817	DMC 817
DMC 721	DMC 721
DMC 742	DMC 742
DMC 700	DMC 700
DMC 995	DMC 995
DMC 550	DMC 550


The following is worked as a single long stitch:




Finishing: Cut around the stitched area, 6 squares outside the stem-stitch border. Unravel 3 rows of squares to form the fringe, leaving 3 rows between the border and the fringe.

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


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
